[VISA INFORMATION](#)

In general, the following applies:

- Participants from EU/Schengen countries: no visa required
- Participants from the UK, USA, and other countries with visa-free access for short stays (up to 90 days): visa not required for short visits
- Participants from visa-required third countries:
 - Visa must be applied for **at the Austrian Embassy**, as Austria is the main destination
 - Entry via Germany (e.g., flight to Munich) is acceptable as long as Austria is the main destination

Invitation Letter Requirements (for Visa Purposes):

Each invitation letter will include:

- Name and passport details of the invitee (see attachment)
 - Pass no.
 - Date of birth
 - Issue date
 - Expiry date
- Event duration and dates
- Event location
- Purpose of the visit
- Confirmation of who will cover travel and accommodation costs
- Contact information of the inviting company
- Company letterhead and authorized signature

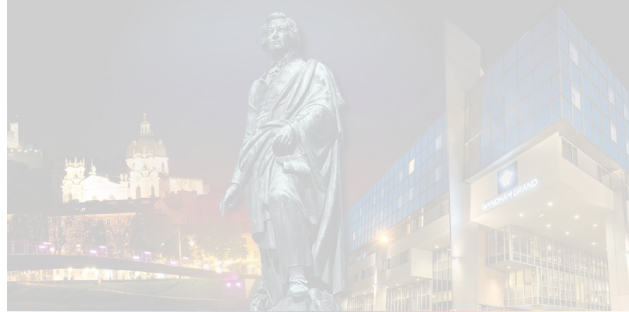

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HOW TO GET TO SALZBURG

Air Travel Section

- Next airport: Salzburg W. A. Mozart Airport (SZG)
- Transfer to hotel: about 30 minutes
- Bus connections: City of Salzburg Line 2 (Walserfeld–Airport–Main Station–Obergnigl) runs daily at short intervals from the airport to the main train station (23 min travel time). Tickets are available at machines or online (Salzburg Transport). From the "Airport" stop, a covered footpath leads to the check-in counter.

Alternative: Munich Airport (MUC)

- Transfer to hotel: about 2 ½ hours by train

Rail Travel Section

- Main train station: Salzburg Hauptbahnhof (Hbf)
- Walking distance to hotel: about 6 minutes
- Connections: Railjet and regional trains to Munich & Vienna

Tram/Light Rail Travel Section

- Network: Salzburger Straßenbahn
- Next stops: about 5–15 minutes walking distance to the Conference Centre
- Note: Check line routes.

Car Travel Section

- Address: Radisson Blu Hotel & Conference Centre, Strassenbahnweg 3, 5020 Salzburg
- Parking: hotel garage or public garages
- Note: No vignette is required for the direct journey from Germany (Walserberg border) to the Salzburg-Nord junction on the A1 Westautobahn.
- Note: Consider seasonal traffic times.

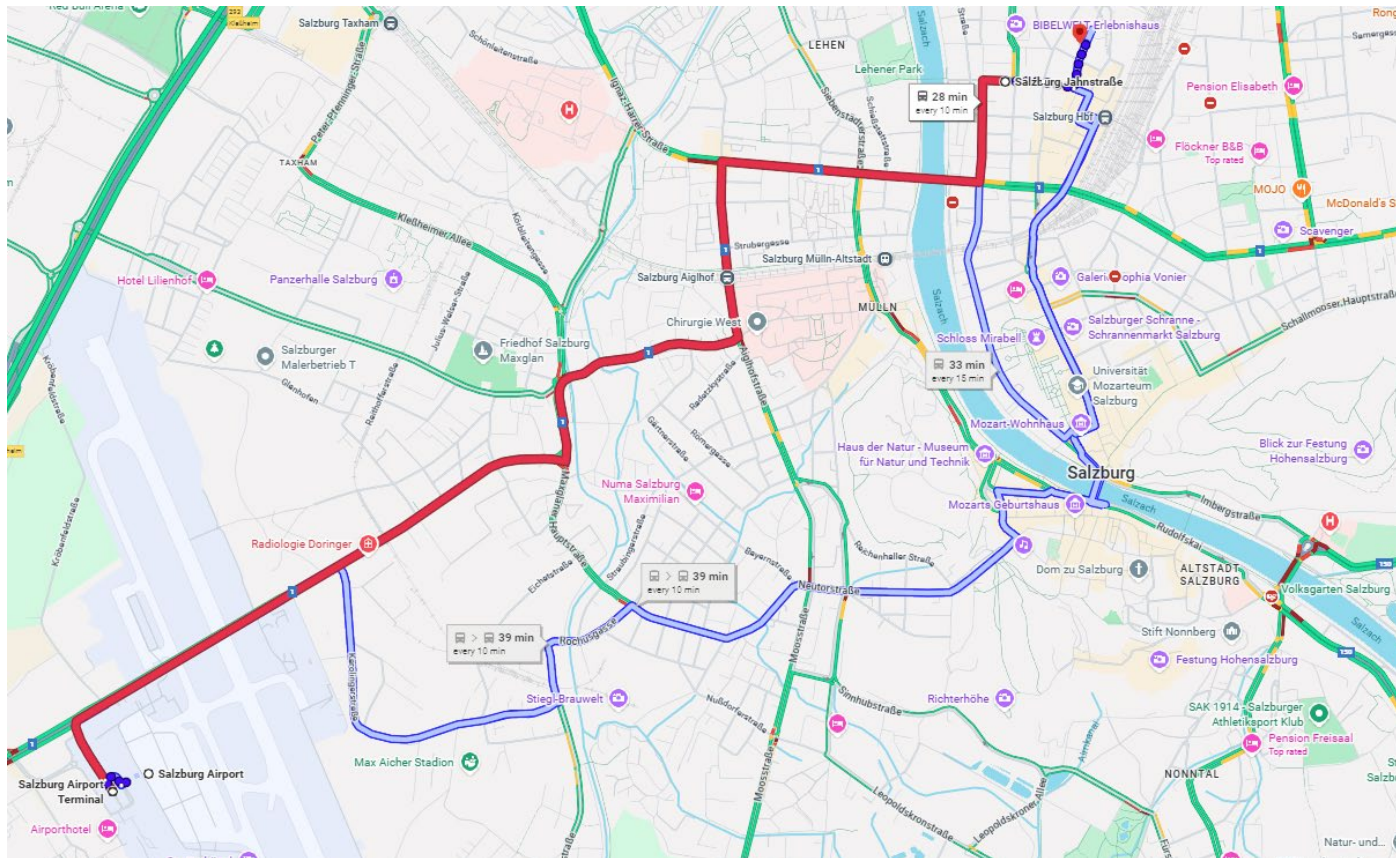

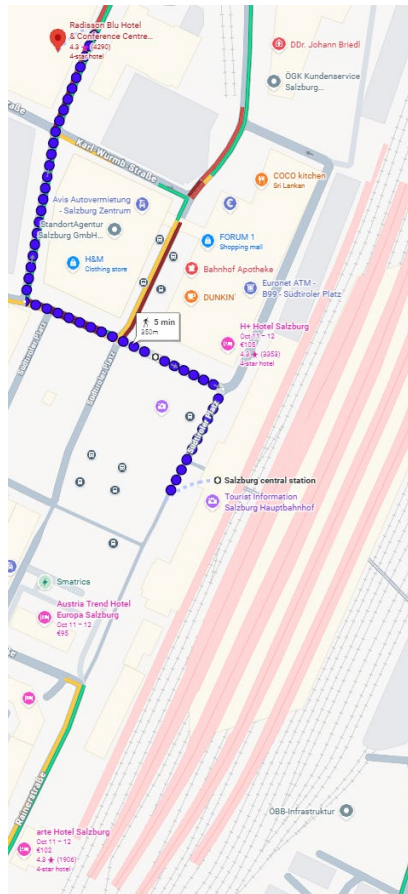
